David plays "Four Limbs" for the first time in the Midwest!



During the weekend of February 22-24, David served in Lincoln, Nebraska. He played at Union College and Eastridge Presbyterian Church, two venues that have hosted him in the past. What was new about this experience was that Pastor Jim Crelin at Eastridge wanted to make sure David was able to play "Four Limbs" for his congregation. So he agreed to cover the cost of shipping David's custom apparatus (which includes a special "foot cradle" as well as a custom stool) to Lincoln. Since David can only fly with one guitar, he needed to borrow one while he was in town. Brian Kohel, a member of Eastridge, loaned David his Takamine acoustic, and David played it with his feet on Friday and Sunday. Students and guests at Union College as well as member and guests of Eastridge looked on as David played two guitars at the same time. It was an historic moment. From now on, David can extend the option to venues outside the Pacific Northwest to have him ship his "Four Limbs" apparatus so he can play this special song!
