

The David Harsh Guitar Symposium

*The 3rd annual weekend of exciting musical pursuits
in beautiful Seabeck, Washington*

Who: Intermediate students of the guitar (ages 18 and older) who perform, write songs, or lead worship in a Christian setting.

What: Several group classes will be taught using multi-media on a variety of relevant guitar subjects. Each participant will receive a binder full of tables, outlines and diagrams containing material from the weekend.

When: Friday, January 20 – Sunday, January 22, 2012.

Cost: \$550.00 per student (includes food, lodging, and all instructional sessions from Friday evening—Sunday afternoon.) Early bird rate available.

Details: Students arrive on Friday evening in time for dinner. Afterwards, everyone will gather for a music circle and a time of optional song sharing. Saturday and Sunday mornings will begin with David leading a devotion and a time of worship. Throughout both days, David will present multiple in-depth sessions of dynamic guitar instruction with a special emphasis on rhythm guitar playing. Additional classes on songwriting and worship leading will also be offered. Throughout the weekend, students will have multiple opportunities to ask questions, and to dialogue about various aspects of guitar-driven Christian music.

Topics: Fretboard mapping, moveable chords, scales, theory, embellishments, inversions, suspensions, transposition, strumming patterns, fingerstyle patterns, the CAGED system, non-diatonic chords, several custom capos, alternate tunings, two-hand tapping, looping technology, tuning by ear, and much more.
