DAVID HARSH: TESTIMONIAL

I have spent many years searching for significance. I have tried, through the years, to accomplish things that might make me a better person. I have also stumbled, falling into many of the traps that exist along the path of a seeking Christian. My efforts alone were not enough.

Finally, I had a breakthrough. I realized that my accomplishments and my failures do not determine my significance or my identity. I am a child of God. That is who I am, and who I was created to be. I find only a temporary kind of peace through what I may achieve, and it's easy to believe the lie that my identity is determined by my failures. My true, lasting peace is found through discovering God's creation in me. Now I desire to bless others through the message I bring.

The music I write expresses the joy of being a child of God, and also the difficulty of being human. For in humanity there exist many struggles, including pride, loss, and pain. But God has shown me, often through the songs He inspires me to write, that He is able to overcome all of these challenges.

Each time I write a song, I feel I am coming to grips with a struggle I have, or a joy I am celebrating. Either way, there is a truth to tell. In the process of sharing these songs, I embrace the possibility that someone, somewhere may hear these words and be able to claim some of them as their own. Sometimes, if I really listen to my own words, I find that it's actually me that God is trying to speak to.

The Lord has entrusted these truths to me, and one day, when I see His face, I want to be able to tell Him that I have shared them with others. That is why I do what I do.

DAVID HARSH: STATEMENT OF FAITH

I believe the Holy Bible to be the Inspired Word of God. I believe that by my sinful nature, I cannot have communion with God, but because Jesus Christ died and took my place on the cross, I have been given that opportunity. I believe that it is my calling to share the Truths that He has laid on my heart with as many people as I can. The fact that I am a musician is not central to this - it is just a means of sharing my faith.
